

SECTION H

CONSERVATION PLAN

1. It shall be prohibited for any owner or occupant or for any person, individual, corporation, or partnership in apparent control of potable water received from East Central Special Utility District to intentionally, knowingly, recklessly, or negligently perform landscape watering or to allow or cause landscape watering with said potable water from 10:00 A.M to 8:00 P.M. per calendar day by using individual sprinklers or sprinkler systems. "Individual sprinklers" or "sprinkler systems" shall mean any method or device used for the application of water to the property. "Landscape watering" shall be defined as the application of water to any member of the plant kingdom, including any tree, shrub, vine, herb, flower, succulent, groundcover or grass species that grows or has been planted outdoors. "Potable water" is any water that has been treated for human use delivered through a metering device. Only the following methods of landscape watering are permitted at any time:
 - a. Landscape watering with a hand held hose with a manual or automatic shut-off operated by one person;
 - b. Landscape watering with a bucket having a holding capacity of five (5) gallons or less; and
 - b. Landscape watering with a drip irrigation system. "Drip irrigation" shall mean an automatic water-saving irrigation system (drip, porous pipe, etc.)

2. Enforcement and Penalties

First offense:	Written Warning.
Second offense:	The General Manager will issue a second written warning or the service can be turned off depending upon the violation.
Third offense:	Service will be turned off and locked or a penalty will be added to the bill depending upon the violation.
